Songwriter's notes: To add further richness and depth to the meaning, follow the first verse with the second and/or third verse:

3. We are not alone; we are here together. We are not alone; we are here now.

Translator's note: This translation is in the 'familiar' (not 'formal') form. Most Spanish-speaking clients will be comfortable with this form. The symbol @ stands for an 'o' or 'a', depending on the gender: in verse 1, the gender of the client ('solo' for male, 'sola' for female); in verse 2, the gender of the singer ('solo' for male, 'sola' for female); and in verse 3, everyone present ('juntas' if all are female, otherwise 'juntos').
